

Subject: Third Party RTI Audit Summary Report for Bharat PetroResources Ltd.

The **Right to Information Act, 2005**, which enables citizens with unprecedented access to information held by public authorities.

Allow citizens to access vital information without the need to file individual RTI requests.

We appreciate the committed efforts of **Bharat PetroResources Ltd. (BPRL)** as a Public Authority for maintaining transparency by proactively sharing key information on its official website.

However, during the course of the Third-Party RTI Transparency Audit, certain observations have been made regarding areas that need further clarity or improvement in voluntary disclosures. These are summarized as below:

Observations & Recommendations:

It is observed that the following disclosures to be made available on the public (BPRL Site) domain :

- *Transfer policy and transfer orders of employees.*
- *Foreign and domestic tours of officials of the rank of JS & above.*
- *Replies to questions asked in the Parliament.*

Positive Feedback & Way Forward

BPRL's efforts towards maintaining statutory disclosures under the RTI Act, 2005 and the **positive approach toward transparency is commendable.**

It is recommended that BPRL to continue their efforts to;

- Ensure all relevant information, documents, and links mapped to the **Transparency Audit Matrix.**
- Incorporate a **revision log or update tracker** on the RTI/Disclosure page for better monitoring.
- Align all disclosures with **DoPT guidelines** to ensure standardization and ease of access for citizens.

We look forward to BPRL continuing best practices in proactive information disclosure.
